He was first elected to the Victorian Parliament as Member for East Yarra Province in 1996 and re-elected in 2002. In 2006, David was elected a member of the new Southern Metropolitan Region and was re-elected in 2010.

David's academic background includes a Bachelor of Applied Science, a Bachelor of Arts and a Graduate Diploma in Arts (Applied Philosophy). Prior to entering Parliament he was a Chiropractor in private practice.

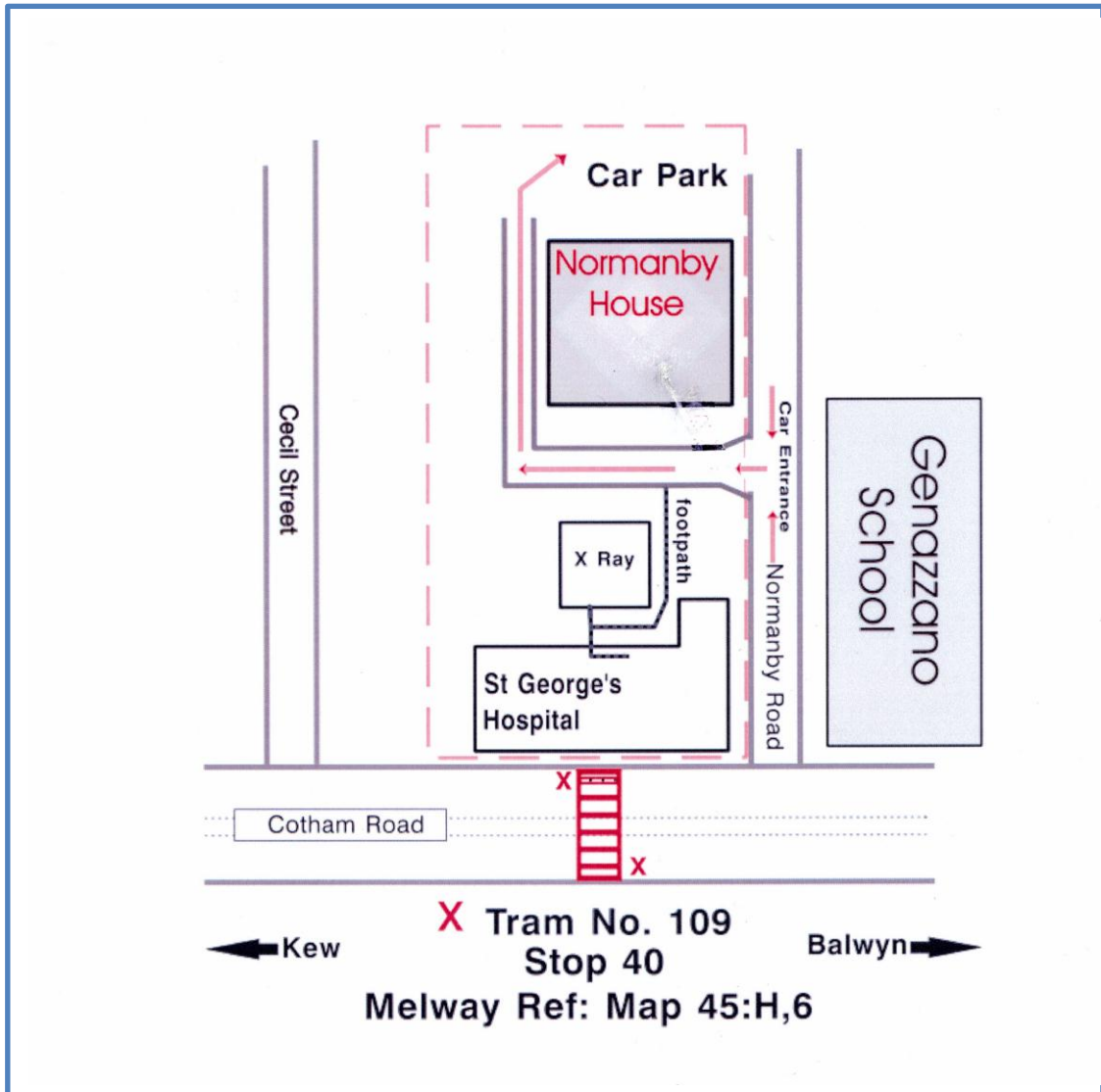

David has been a member of the Public Accounts and Estimates Committee and the Law Reform Committee of the Victorian Parliament.

David has held Shadow Ministerial responsibility for Health, Planning, Manufacturing & Exports, Small Business, Industry & State Development, Major Projects and Environment & Climate Change and more recently Health and Ageing along with responsibility for Scrutiny of Government.

David is currently the Leader of the Government in the Legislative Council and is Minister for Health and Minister for Ageing.
