Professor Iris Chi taught at the University of Hong Kong for 17 years and is currently at the University of Southern California in the US lecturing aging-related courses in the Master of Social Work program. An expert in elderly health and gerontology, Dr. Chi has participated in more than 80 studies and published more than 200 articles on long-term care, physical and mental health, social support and intergenerational relationship. Dr. Chi is an honorary professor, member, consultant and advisor to more than 30 US and overseas elderly-related organizations such as the World Health Organization, Peking University and University of Victoria in BC, Canada. A career milestone came in 2004 when the city of Hong Kong honored Dr. Chi with the prestigious Bronze Bauhinia Star for her public and community service with the city's aging population.
