# Indigenous Ageing: Tools for Better Practice

*Despite the major mortality gap experienced by Indigenous people, particularly in Australia, older Indigenous people in Australia and New Zealand represent a growing proportion of the Indigenous population with distinct healthcare and social needs. For older Indigenous people, health inequalities are further exacerbated by barriers in assessment and lack of clear pathways for assessment and management. The lack of specific, validated assessment tools, creates problems in helping Indigenous communities to manage dementia and other conditions associated with ageing. This reduces access to mainstream and specific programs of health service delivery, despite the higher level of actual need.*

Eddie Strivens will address the issues of cognitive assessment in rural and urban aboriginal and Torres Strait islander communities and introduce the KICA suite of tools and their use in Far North Queensland. Leon Flicker will discuss some of the issues with other assessments focusing on depression, functional impairment, falls and continence.

Lorna Dyall will discuss the lessons learnt and need for community engagement from developing a feasibility study and a longitudinal cohort study "Te Puawaitanga o Nga Tapuwae Kia Ora Tonu Life and Living in Advanced Age : a Cohort Study in New Zealand. The importance of developing partnerships cannot be underestimated in this area.
