There is an opportunity for LGBTI Australians to ask: what do we know? And what more do we need to know? Applying the broad lens of Australia's national survey (Older Australia at a Glance) provides a new framework for understanding older LGBTI Australians.

This MasterClass explores the characteristics and circumstances of older LGBTI Australians. It describes each subgroup in the LGBTI collective and outlines four key topics of interest such as:

1. The changing demographic profile
2. Social and economic context including: providing care; community and civic participation; social participation; housing and wealth
3. Health and functioning including: ageing and health risk factors; disability; dementia and mental health
4. The use of health and aged care services including: care needs and sources of care; aged care assessment; home services and residential aged care.

This innovative approach will explore what is known and what must be known by drawing on Australian and international research. Participants will be provided with a broad understanding of the issues for older LGBTI Australians and the implications for LGBTI inclusive services. The workshop will focus around a workbook which participants are invited to utilise as a resource for their workplace.

This MasterClass will be of interest and value to service providers, policy makers, researchers.
