Palliative Care & Dementia: Research & Practice

Palliative care has historically been focused on meeting the needs of people with terminal cancer. It is now increasingly recognised as the best approach to caring for people with a range of terminal illnesses including dementia.

This seminar will address the topics of dementia and palliative care, palliative care for people with life-limiting illnesses, and the role of carers towards the end of life.
